

44th HIGH TEMPLE WORKSHOP Invitation Package

1. INVITEE:

You are cordially invited to attend and participate in the 44th High Temperature Polymeric Laminate (High Temple) Workshop, administered by the University of Dayton Research Institute (UDRI), to be held 10-13 February 2025 at Renaissance Asheville Downtown Hotel in Asheville, North Carolina.

2. FORMAT:

A tentative agenda is included. A workshop program containing all the abstracts will be available to Workshop attendees at the registration desk. Presentation material will be made available to all attendees by April 1, 2025 via CD or by logging into the NAMIS website. All sessions will be unclassified and will be held at Renaissance Asheville Downtown Hotel in Asheville, North Carolina.

3. RESTRICTED ATTENDANCE:

The material to be presented and discussed at the Workshop may contain information covered under the International Traffic in Arms Regulation (ITAR) or the Export Administration Regulation (EAR). Because of this, attendance will be restricted to U.S. persons (citizens or legal permanent residents). Furthermore, all nongovernment employees must ensure that their employer is pre-registered with the Defense Logistics Service Center (DD Form 2345, Military Critical Technical Data Agreement). Attendance to the Workshop will be limited to U.S. persons eligible to receive controlled unclassified information (CUI), limited distribution information from the Department of Defense, and export-controlled technical data.

All non-government employees (private industry, government contractors, academia, etc.) who attend the Workshop MUST:

- Have your company immediately fill out and return the Military Critical Technical Data Agreement, DD
 Form 2345, to the <u>Defense Logistics Service Center website</u>. If your company is currently registered, you
 need not register again. Provide the certification number (block 7B of DD 2345) on the High Temple
 registration form and bring a hard copy of your DD 2345 to the workshop registration desk.
- Bring a photo I.D. to the Workshop (driver's license, Passport, Common Access Card, etc.).
- Bring proof of U.S. citizenship or legal permanent residence to the Workshop (Passport, green card, etc.).
- Bring proof of company affiliation to the Workshop. A business card is <u>NOT</u> an acceptable form of proof of employment. An organization *photo* ID, pay stub, or letter from your HR department are acceptable.

All government employees (military, government civilians, etc.) who attend the Workshop must:

• Bring a valid photo government I.D. (Common Access Card/Military I.D.) to the Workshop.

4. **REGISTRATION:**

Advanced registration prior to Friday, 31 January 2025 is required. Complete registration by 31 January 2025, using one of the following registration options:

5. PAYMENT:

The registration fee for the 44th High Temple Workshop must be paid using one of the four following options:

A. (*Preferred Method*) Prepay <u>\$750</u> using a major credit card. Payments using a credit card must be made prior to 31 January 2025. To pay with a credit card, please register online and pay via the secured payment site. <u>Online High Temple Registration Link</u>

Credit card payments must be made in advance and will not be accepted at the workshop registration desk.

- B. Prepay <u>\$750</u> prior to 31 January 2025 by sending a check to Kaitlin Rigitano, 300 College Park, Dayton, OH 45469-0052. Make the check payable to the UNIVERSITY OF DAYTON.
- C. Pay \$750 via check made payable to the UNIVERSITY OF DAYTON at the registration desk.
- D. Pay \$750 in cash at the registration desk.

The payment options listed above are the only accepted methods of payment. In addition, registration cancellations must be received by 31 January 2025 in order to receive a refund. No refunds will be processed after 31 January 2025.

6. LODGING:

All participants are required to make their own lodging and transportation arrangements. Room blocks have been set aside for High Temple Workshop attendees at the Renaissance Asheville Downtown Hotel. **CUT-OFF DATE FOR ROOM RESERVATIONS IS MONDAY, 20 JANUARY 2025**. The group rate WILL NOT be honored after that date. Reservations can be made by calling the Renaissance Asheville Downtown Hotel or booking online using the links listed below. Reservations must be guaranteed using a major credit card. Attendees may cancel their room up to 48 hours prior to arrival without penalty. If cancelled less than 48 hours prior, a one-night room and tax charge will apply.

High Temple Workshop <u>Federal Government</u> <u>Block</u>: A small block of rooms has also been reserved at the 2025 prevailing Federal Government per diem rate (currently \$107 per night + local/state taxes) for military and U.S. Federal Government employees traveling on official government business. 7. TRANSPORTATION:

A. Asheville Regional Airport (AVL):

The Asheville Regional Airport is located approximately 15 miles from the Renaissance Asheville Downtown Hotel, and is serviced by American Airlines, Delta Airlines, and United and most major car rental companies.

B. Greenville-Spartanburg Int. Airport (GSP):

The Greenville-Spartanburg International Airport is located approximately 78 miles from the Renaissance Asheville Downtown Hotel, and is serviced by American Airlines, Delta Air Lines, Southwest Airlines, and United, and most major car rental companies.

C. Charlotte Douglas Int. Airport (CLT):

The Charlotte Douglas International Airport is located approximately 124 miles from the Renaissance Asheville Downtown Hotel, and is serviced by most major airlines and car rental companies.




